- Erosion Control is an important part of this project. Contractor shall die berms, swales, silt fance, and ditch checks necessary to prevent sion from leaving the property
- All backfill shall be tamped. Backfill within the right-of-way shall be 95%
- The Contractor shall obtain all necessary permits required prior to struction.
- 7. Prior to commencement of work, the contractor shall notify all those companies which have facilities in the vicinity 72 hours prior to the construction to be performed.

 B. All structures facilities.
- B. All structures, fences, povement, and other improvements disturbed by construction activities shall be restored by the contractor to original or better conditions.

 B. The contractor is responsible for providing berms, silt fences, straw bales or other means to prevent erosion from reaching the Public right of way.  10. All areas disturbed by the contractor shall be seeded. Right-of-way, engineered sweles and common areas shall be blended fescue toterant of full sun conditions. All other disturbed areas shall be a certified perennial rye grass with 30 K K-31 fescue blend.

- All contractor staging and employee parking shall be confined to the Sitle. Under no circumstances shall existing right-of-way be utilized as staging or parking areas.

 All slopes steeper than 6:1 shall have and even layer of mulch applie in addition to seeding.
