The Lawrence Juneteenth Planning Committee is organizing a series of events such as a essay/poster contest, an oral history and gospel choir showcase, a 3 on 3 basketball tournament, a unity march, family festival and prayer breakfast. All events are educational and multi-cultural in nature and reflect well upon the City of Lawrence's history of struggle as a "free state," and to the City's commitment to civil rights. This grass roots effort has obtained support from the University of Kansas, the Lawrence Arts Commission, and most notably, from the Lawrence Boys and Girls Club. The committee is currently in the process of garnering additional support from other private organizations and individuals in the community.

The Lawrence Juneteenth Celebration provides an opportunity for the families to spend a little time in remembrance and understanding about how the key values of freedom and respect have shaped and continue to shape our nation and our city's history and future.
