

I am writing expressing the concern of the Breezedale Neighborhood Association about a few traffic issues we are having. First I would like to see if we could get a speeding assessment done on Winona Ave. There are about 15 kids who live on our I block street and there is absolutely no reason to speed down Winona. It seems to be the worst around 3:00 in the afternoon and at night. Whenever 23rd street is really busy we get eastbound traffic jumping one block over, zooming down Winona and back up to 23rd to try and pick up a few spots in traffic. We would love to see at least one speed bump placed on Winona.

Regarding the intersection of 23rd and Mass., navigating this intersection can be very dangerous. When turning west onto 23rd from the south side of Mass. it is nearly impossible to see any traffic that may be coming straight down Mass. intending to cross 23rd and enter Breezedale. Also if you intend to go north on Mass. straight across 23rd, the traffic turning east onto 23rd from the north side of Mass. will often turn right in front of you as if they have the right if way. You and I spoke a month or so ago about a turn signal at 23rd and Mass. and you had told me that the neighbors voted against it. I believe it is time we reassess this situation. Every member at our last neighborhood meeting felt that this intersection is an accident waiting to happen. We are hoping that the city will see the need to bring this intersection under control. Please let me know how I can be of assistance and what steps I will need to take to get these items addressed.
