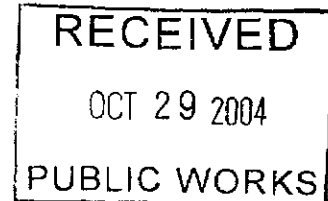

I am pleased to announce that your proposed KLINK Resurfacing project from Irving Hill Road Overpass to Harvard Road on Iowa Street (US-59) and from approximately 0.13 mile west of Harper Street to the East City Limits on 23rd Street (K-10) has been selected for funding and will be included in the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) City Connecting Links "KLINK" Resurfacing Program.

Over the past five years, 116 projects totaling nearly \$36 million have been initiated through this program with KDOT funding approximately \$18 million in improvements and local governments, \$18 million. These improvements couldn't have happened without local partners and KDOT working together.

Your project has been programmed for FY 2007, and KDOT's Bureau of Local Projects will be contacting you regarding the process to get it underway. Please see the attached letter for further details regarding your project's funding. We appreciate your application to the Local Partnership Program. By combining resources, KDOT and you, our local partners, are making a difference in improving the State's transportation system.
