I am pleased to announce that your proposed KLINK Resurfacing project from 23rd Street (K-10) to Irving Hill Road Overpass and Harvard Road to 6th Street (US-40) on Iowa Street (US-59) has been selected for funding and will be included in the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) City Connecting Links "KLINK" Resurfacing Program.

Over the past five years, 123 projects totaling nearly \$39 million have been initiated through this program with KDOT funding approximately \$18 million in improvements and local governments, \$21 million. These improvements couldn't have happened without local partners and KDOT working together.

Your project has been programmed for FY 2008, and KDOT's Bureau of Local Projects will be contacting you regarding the process to get it underway.
