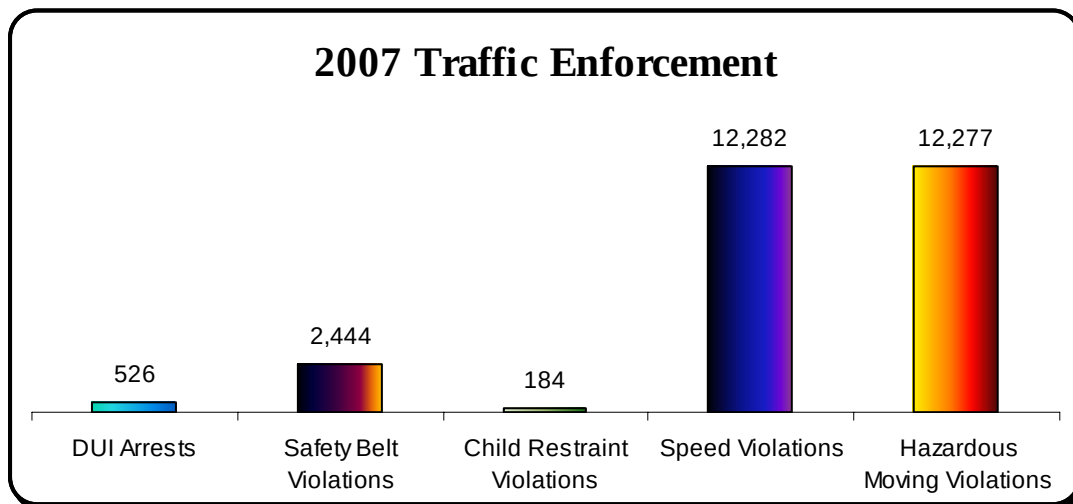
Officer Receiving Call from Dispatch
to Officer Arrival Priority 1-7





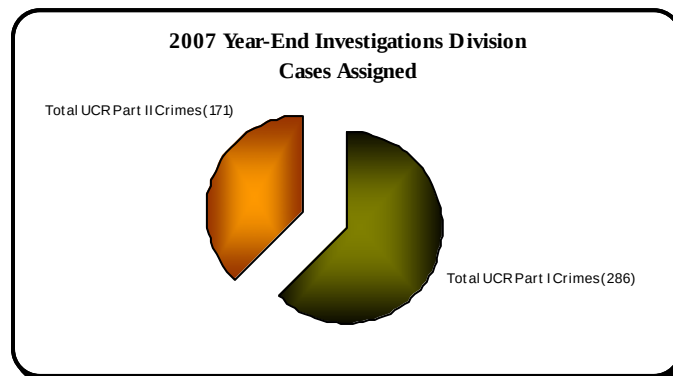

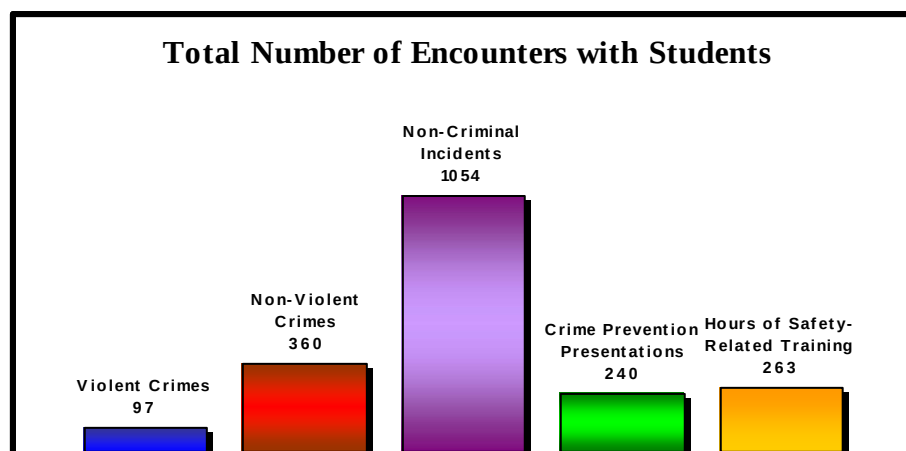

Officer Phillips is the recipient of the Reverance for Law Award from the Fraternal Order of Eagles.



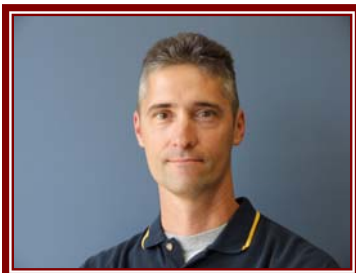
Detective Sean Brown
