I would like to encourage the City Commission to follow the recommendation of the Transportation Commission, as opposed to the staff recommendation. At the public meeting, public discussion on this matter stretched for a matter of twenty to thirty minutes, and the commission was persuaded that various unique factors did not appear in the raw data produced by the study. These included:

- the curvature of the road, which inhibits visibility, particularly when traveling eastbound, toward Iowa Street
- the fact that although the average of the three data points tested was a touch below the 5 mph threshold that would trigger recommendation, the middle section produced speeds well over that 5 mph threshold, and given that this is the heart of the residential street, that it is also the most densely populated and used by pedestrians, playing children, and the like

For these reasons, I would request that the City Commission approve calming of some sort (speed bumps, one-way, roundabout).
