SPECIAL PROVISIONS

1. CONTACT INFORMATION:

- a. Trent Robinett is the person designated as responsible for the overall safety of UAS operations under this Certificate of Waiver or Authorization. During UAS operations for on-site communication/recall, the Responsible Person shall be continuously available for direct contact at 816-874-4655 by Kansas ARTCC or designated representative.
- b. The Responsible Person listed on this Authorization must maintain a current list of pilots by name and the remote pilot certificate number(s) associated with the Authorization holder's operation. This list must be presented for inspection upon request from the Administrator or an authorized representative.

2. SCHEDULE OF FLIGHT OPERATIONS:

- a. This Certificate of Waiver or Authorization and the Special Provisions shall be in effect between civil sunrise and civil sunset local time.
- b. This airspace authorization does not relieve the remote pilots from the responsibility to check the airspace they are operating in and comply with all restrictions that may be present in accordance with see 14 CFR 107.45 and 107.49 (a)(2), such as restricted and Prohibited Airspace, Temporary Flight Restrictions, etc.
- c. The facility may disapprove, terminate, restrict, or delay UAS flight operations covered by this authorization at any time.
 - 1) If the proponent's operational altitude is at or below the altitude authorized by the UASFM, the operation may be conducted in accordance with Part 107 rules. However, if the proponent's operational altitude is higher than that authorized by the UASFM, then the operation cannot be conducted unless a separate authorization is approved through the Part 107.41 process. If an operation spans more than one grid, your altitude is limited to the lowest value.
 - 2) If the map for the facility listed in Operations Authorized above is not yet published, then an attachment will be provided as Attachment 1 of this Authorization indicating the operating area and authorized altitudes.
- d. To prevent sUAS contact with Special VFR (SVFR) operations, sUAS operations are not authorized when there is a ceiling of less than 1,000 feet AGL.

3. EMERGENCY/CONTINGENCY PROCEDURES - Lost Link/Lost
Communications Procedures:

- a. If the UAS loses communications or loses its GPS signal, the UA must return to a pre-determined location within the operating area and land.
- b. The PIC must abort the flight in the event of unpredicted obstacles or emergencies.

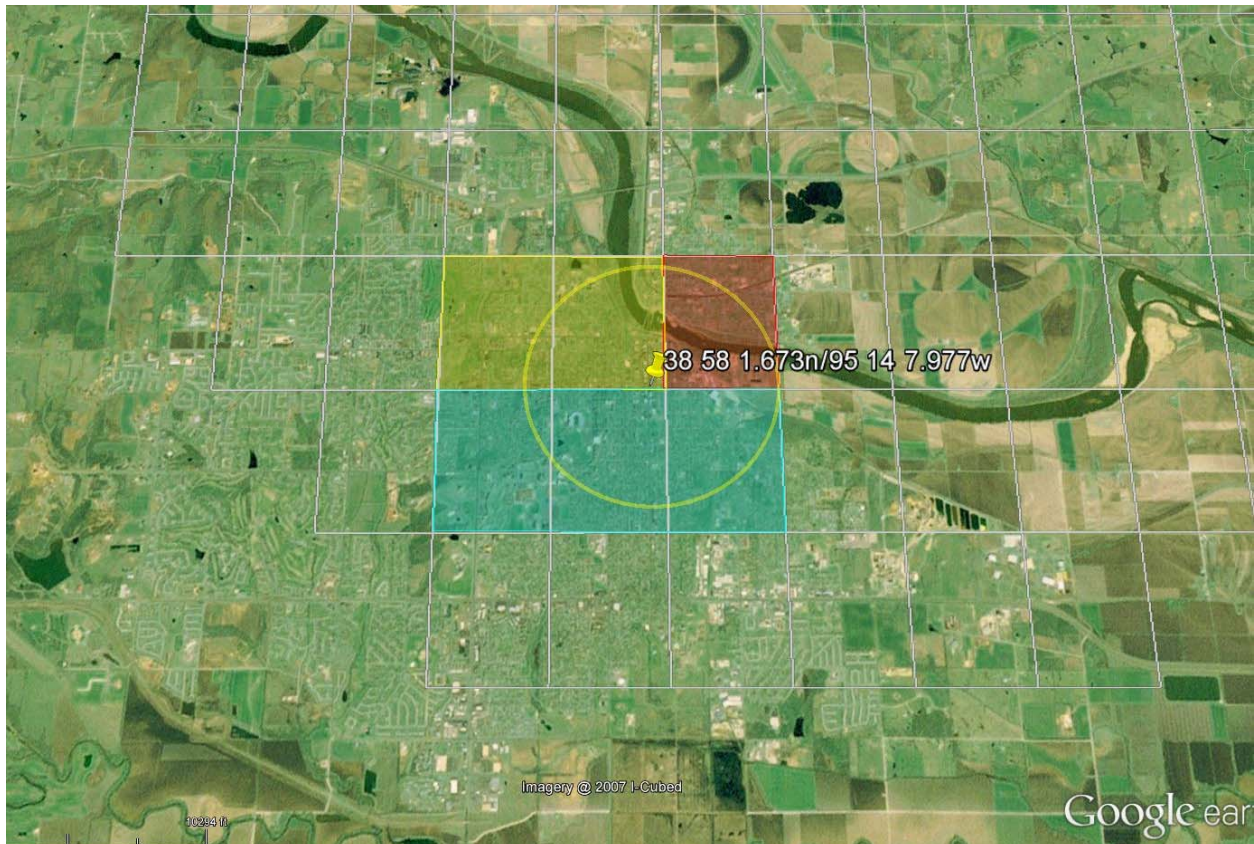
Operations Area
