Re: Authorizing an Exception to the Lawrence-Douglas County Housing Authority (LDCHA) Authorizing Resolution 00-26 / 6240 for the Tier III Housing Project

Dear Mayor Boley and Mr. Markus,

The LDCHA has been working with Douglas County and Bert Nash to plan a project to develop 8-10 units of permanent supportive housing adjacent to the proposed crisis center, referred to as the Tier III project. According to Resolution 00-26 / 6240, Section III, any property purchased by LDCHA must be titled to the City of Lawrence. The County is handling this development and will be the owner of the land. I understand the County has discussed with you the possibility of a Joint Resolution granting an exception to Section III of the LDCHA Authorizing Resolution that would permit the LDCHA to purchase this property and have it deeded to the Douglas County c/o the LDCHA.

The Housing Authority supports this case specific exception which will facilitate the Tier III project.
