Thus far the Center is well on the way to accomplishing the goals outlined in the funding proposal –

1. From January 1, 2010 to June 30, 2010 the Center has provided 266 supervised visits and 316 monitored exchanges. This has served 134 children from 87 families.
2. There have been no situations of parental violence at the Center.
3. There have been no security violations/incidents during services.

Funds continue to be used toward the VEC Manager's salary as this position provides supervision, oversight, direct service provision and other duties to maintain the quality of services at this Center.
