

# Yard Waste Program & Facility Information

## Residential Curbside Collection

- Solid Waste Division collects yard waste on Monday mornings March through mid-December, except holidays.
- Set out yard waste by 6:00 a.m. on Mondays only.
- Set out in cans, city carts (trash carts or yard waste carts) or compostable paper yard waste bags.
- Bundles also accepted (must not exceed 5-feet in length or 18-inches in diameter; must not weigh more than 65-pounds). Bundles must be tied with durable string or twine (please do not use wire, duct tape, etc.).



## Yard Waste Public Drop-off

- 1420 E. 11th Street, Saturdays, March through mid-December, 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- Drop off brush and other yard waste including leaves, grass clippings and garden waste. Cost: \$5 per pickup truck load (more for larger trucks). Cash only.
- **NEW!!!** Residents may purchase compost and woodchips during Saturday dates and times listed above. Self-load only, bring a shovel. Cost: \$10 per pickup truck load (more for larger trucks). Cash only.

- Thursday through Saturday, March 27, 28, 29 from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., rain or shine.
- City will load trucks and trailers.
- \$10 per bucket load, approx. two cubic yards, cash only.
- Compost and woodchips are not intended for commercial applications but rather for the citizens of Lawrence. Dump truck quantities are not allowed. The city cannot load trucks with ladder racks.
