Shelter & Park Rental Policies:

- Park rentals must be processed at the Admin Office by calling (785) 832-3450 or email parksrec@lawrenceks.org.
- Special Use Permits must be processed at the Admin Office by calling (785) 832-3450 or email parksrec@lawrenceks.org.
- Shelters and gazebo rentals can be processed in person at any LPRD facility or on-line at www.lprd.org.
- All shelters, gazebos, and parks reservations must be made 3 business days in advance.
- Reservations are taken one year in advance of the day being requested.
- Shelters, gazebos and parks are available to reserve for use from April 15 through October 30, weather permitting.
- Use of shelters, gazebos, and parks November 1 through April 14 are first come first serve. Bathrooms will be locked, water will be off and electricity will be shut off. (Rotary Arboretum has heated restroom on site open year around).
- Public Parks within the city will be open daily to the public from 6 a.m. to 11:30 p.m. (Burcham park: 5 a.m. to 10:30 p.m.)
- Rental Party shall be responsible for the clean-up of shelters, gazebos, and parks.
- Glass bottles are prohibited.
- The use of tobacco products or smoking delivery devices in parks is prohibited.
- All shelters, gazebos, and parks rental fees must be paid at the time of reservation.
- All shelters, gazebos, and parks rental fees are non-refundable.
- Alcohol is permitted with a \$25 permit fee.
- A Special Use Permit is required for events that are open to the public, involve admission fees, user fees, and/or meet other non-public use criteria.
- Lawrence Public Library Lawn is open to the public with a special use permit.
- No fees for Lawrence Public Library employee holding library events on the library lawn.
- No Swimming or Boating in ponds or streams with-in the park
- Dogs and cats in public parks must be kept on a leash at all times.
