Anecdotal Documentation of Partnerships, Special Programs or Good Neighboring Stories:

- Our annual neighborhood picnic was again a big success! About 100 attendees enjoyed
 the second largest picnic in recent memory. Donations from neighbors and local
 businesses provided services and food for the picnic, including printing services,
 art/craft supplies, Italian ice, hotdogs, bounce castle, haircuts, water jug, ice, music,
 photography services and grocery gift certificates. In addition neighborhood residents
 and businesses donated approximately \$700 in the fundraising concurrent with picnic
 efforts.
- Our "social media" outreach is continuing. The revamped website at http://pinckneyneighborhood.org/ continues to flourish we have logged over 175 unique visitors in this quarter. Pinckney Neighborhood has 60 followers on Facebook, steadily adding a few more each month.
 Both the website and Facebook page are repositories for photos of neighborhood events, such as the picnic. We also post all meeting announcements and newsletters there.
- At our July meeting we heard from guest Deron Belt about a music event that will be held in Burcham Park in early October. In addition to addressing neighbors' concerns about noise and traffic, we are exploring opportunities for Pinckney volunteers to assist in parking and clean-up.
